Wear your favourite book themed t-shirt.

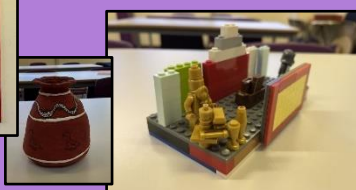
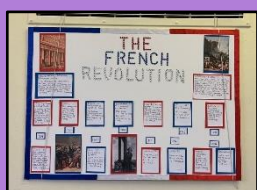

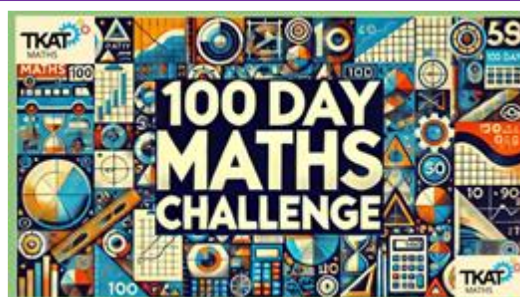
